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Save money and the environment by switching a few everyday items with homemade products.

All-Purpose Spray

- ½ cup distilled white vinegar
- 2 cups water
- 20 drops of essential oils

Pour all ingredients into a spray bottle. Gently swirl the bottle to mix the ingredients together.

Glass & Window Cleaner

- 1 cup warm water
- 1 tbsp cornstarch
- 2tbsp white vinegar
- 2 tbsp rubbing alcohol
- 10 drops essential oils

Add the cornstarch and water to a measuring cup fitted with a spout. Stir until cornstarch is dissolved. Add the remaining ingredients and pour into a spray bottle. Swirling to combine

Homemade Disinfectant Wipes

- 1 cup water
- ¼ cup with vinegar
- 8 drops tea tree oil
- 8 drops eucalyptus essential oil
- 8 drops lemon essential oil
- Empty “wipe” (baby wipe, for example) or jar.
- 15 – 20 squares of cloth (old t-shirts work well, as do old dish towels or similar material)

Fold and place the cloth squares into an empty wipe container or jar and set aside.

Combine in a mixing bowl the water, vinegar, and 3 essential oils, stirring until well mixed.

Pour this mixture over the cloths in the container where they will soak in and be ready for you to pull out and use!

Launder and repeat as often as the cloths hold up!
